## Unauthorized Items

### 1. Accept \$50 Donation to the Kent Fire Department (Draft #2021-029)

### 3. Amend City Property Right of Access Agreement (Draft #2021-031)

Bridget is requesting Council's authorization to amend the access agreement approved in 2019 for the remediation of the property at 800 Mogadore Road (former RB&W site) on the backside of Kramer Ball Fields. The access agreement amendment expands the work area in order to properly safeguard the river from contaminants. (attachment)

### 1. Fire Incident Reports

Chief Tosko has provided a copy of the fire and emergency medical services report for January 2021. In 2021 calls for fire service are down 2% (5 calls); fire mutual aid assistance is unchanged with 1 call as compared to 2020; and EMS responses are up 7% (19 calls). (attachment)

### 2. Health Department Statistics
