## Unauthorized Items

### 1. DORA Hour Extension Request (Draft #2021-056)

The Chamber of Commerce sent a request to the Administration requesting Council's approval to extend the hours of the DORA from 10 pm to 11 pm for one night only, on June 26, 2021, corresponding to the fireworks and live music downtown. (attachment)

#### *Administration Recommendation*

Given the popularity of the DORA and the lack of problems resulting from the DORA, the staff and I recommend Council's authorization to extend the DORA from 10 pm to 11 pm on June 26, 2021 as requested by the Chamber.

#### *Council Action*

**Authorize the extension of the DORA until 11 pm on June 26, 2021 with the Emergency Clause.**

### 2. Authorization of a New ARPA Budgetary Fund (Draft #2021-062)

Rhonda has requested Council's authorization to add a new fund in the City Budget to be used to track ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) funding allocation and use. Rhonda reports that the Ohio Auditor's Office is requiring a designated ARPA fund to properly manage and track ARPA related expenditures. (attachment)

Rhonda Hall has provided a summary of income tax collections for the May of 2021. Overall the City income tax collections YTD are down 5.4% (\$337,122) compared with 2020. For the month of May the City income tax collections are up 13.8% (\$182,454) compared to May 2020. (attachment)
