## Information Items

### 1. Kent Police Statistics

Chief Lee has provided a copy of the police statistics report for June 2018. In 2018 calls for service are down 12% (1,625 calls); traffic citations are down 16% (268 tickets); accident incidents are down 8% (28 incidents) and serious crimes are down 18% (58 cases). (attachment)

### 2. Health Department Statistics

Jeff Neistadt has provided a copy of the statistical report for May 2018. Health Department revenues are up 10% (\$32,824.50) and permits are up 0.5% (2 permits) in 2018 from 2017. (attachment)
